2022 Courage Award Honorees: In Memory of Candy Clark

Candy Clark was a local business owner, community advocate, and served Washington County as a Justice of the Peace for six years. She was the first Executive Director of the Humane Society of the Ozarks and her advocacy for animals continued throughout her life. During her lifetime, Candy was passionate about helping survivors of domestic violence leave abusive situations safely with their pets. While Candy Clark passed away in 2020, her memory and legacy will continue in a critical community resource: the Candy Clark Pet Sanctuary at Peace at Home Family Shelter.
