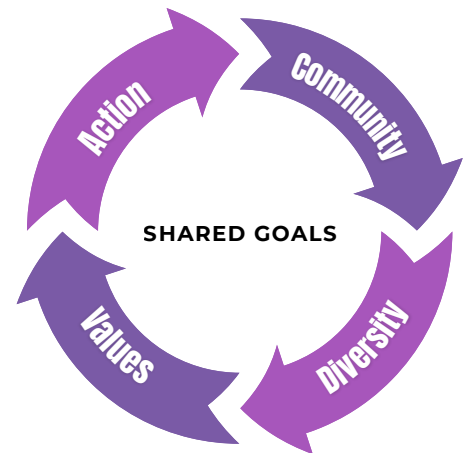
WHAT IS THE CLC?
