This list includes items needed by the shelter as well as items that families and individuals need when they leave the shelter to establish their own homes.

Apparel

- batteries (AA & AAA)
- pots & pans

- cleaning supplies (for new home & shelter use): dish soap, • house slippers bleach, antibacterial wipes, laundry detergent, etc..

- baby supplies: baby wipes, diapers, baby shampoo, bottles, pull-ups, sippy cups, bottle brushes

- medicines: antibiotic cream, Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Aleve, allergy medications, Dramamine, cough drops, lice treatment, Pepto Bismol (child & adult), & children's medication
