This list includes items needed by the shelter as well as items that families and individuals need when they leave the shelter to establish their own homes.

Clothes

- underwear
- adult pajamas
- socks
- baby clothes

Home Goods

- twin and full-sized sheets
- pillows
- towels (all sizes)
- batteries (AA & AAA)
- pots & pans
- silverware
- cleaning supplies (for new home & shelter use): dish soap, bleach, antibacterial wipes, laundry detergent, etc.
- paper towels
- non-perishable food items
- baby supplies: baby wipes, diapers, baby shampoo, bottles, pull-ups

Toiletries

- shampoo and conditioner (full-size bottles)
- body wash
- deodorant
- lotion
- hair products (shampoos, conditioners, gels, mousse, creams, oils & hair sprays, especially for curly & coily hair)
- hairbrushes
- hair ties, clips & bobby pins
- hair dryers
- tweezers
- toilet paper

Miscellaneous

- medicines: antibiotic cream, Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Alieve, allergy medications, Dramamine, cough drops, lice treatment, Pepto Bismol (child & adult), & children's medication
- gift cards (Wal-Mart/Target): for gas, prescriptions, & other expenses
